The Deal!

- 1) 15 % of sale goes to the Club
- 2) 85% to the Seller
- 3) Cash and Carry
- 4) Each item must have your name and price on it. There will be no bartering on your behalf. And, remember, it's a garage sale so please try not to over-price.
- 5) Include an inventory list with your **name**, **item** you are selling, and **price**. If the price accidently falls off the item, it can be checked against the list you provide.
- 6) Items can be brought in Friday evening and/or Saturday morning. If you bring your items on Friday evening, leave your items in a box or bag and they will be laid out later Friday evening or early Saturday morning.
- 7) You are responsible to pick up any items that are not sold on the Sunday after the presentation of prizes (approx. 4:00 pm).

Note: The banker/cashier will prepare an envelope on Sunday with the Seller's name on it, and enclose the amount owed to you. The envelope will be sealed and given to the Seller.

The Club's share will be given to the Treasurer who will include the income received in the Show Statement.





