A limited number of 6' **display tables** will be available for suppliers, retailers, and NAWCA members who wish to demonstrate or sell items.

All display tables must be set up by 9am on the Saturday of the Annual Show & Competition.

## Carvers' Garage Sale!

During the NAWCA Annual Show & Competition at Duggan Community Hall, we will have a table set up to sell carving tools, supplies, books/magazines you no longer need. Thanks to Director-at-Large Marvin Tomnuk for organizing this year's garage sale!

#### The sale will take place on: Saturday, April 28 from 9:00am – 4:00pm and Sunday, April 29 from 10:00am – 3:00pm

#### The Deal!

- 1) 15 % of sale goes to the Club
- 2) 85% to the Seller
- 3) Cash and Carry
- 4) Each item must have your name and price on it. There will be no bartering on your behalf. And, remember, it's a garage sale so please try not to over-price.
- 5) Include an inventory list with your **name**, **item** you are selling, and **price**. If the price accidently falls off the item, it can be checked against the list you provide.
- 6) Items can be brought in Friday evening and/or Saturday morning. If you bring your items on Friday evening, leave your items in a box or bag and they will be laid out later Friday evening or early Saturday morning.
- 7) You are responsible to pick up any items that are not sold on the Sunday after the presentation of prizes (approx. 4:00 pm).

Note: The banker/cashier will prepare an envelope on Sunday with the Seller's name on it, and enclose the amount owed to you. The envelope will be sealed and given to the Seller.

The Club's share will be given to the Treasurer who will include the income received in the Show Statement.



The club has just finished the last of its five wooden quilts! Thanks to everyone for submitting 140+ fantastic tiles! Llew Bertsch beautifully carved all the walnut frames for the quilts, and Mike Leahy expertly built the frames and made the three poplar display easels we used to show the quilts around town. Both have done an outstanding job... thanks again, gentlemen! Also, a huge thank you to Weasel Sedgwick and Bonnie Budge for all the hard work they've put into organizing this huge project! Finally, thanks to Gary Chanin at *Chanin Hardwoods* for donating the walnut and bass wood for the quilts.

The exact details are being finalized, but it looks like all three of our large wooden quilts have found a permanent home at the Edmonton International Airport. It seems that the EIA is planning to make them a part of the *Canada Wall* located in the customs area. We'll keep you up-to-date on these exciting developments!
